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Guidelines for allocation of Open Elective Courses under NEP 2020

Open Elective (OE) Courses are courses which are to be chosen by the students from an unrelated discipline/subject with an intention to seek exposure beyond disciplines of choice.

The purpose of Open Elective Courses is to offer the students the option to expose disciplines of interest beyond the choices they make in Core and Discipline Specific Elective courses. Hence, the students should be encouraged to opt for Open Elective Courses from other streams / faculties. For example, the students of commerce discipline should opt for Open Elective Courses of Science/Arts streams.

Similarly teachers from one discipline should not be allowed to teach the Open Elective Courses of another discipline. For example, the teachers of commerce should not be allowed to teach the Open Elective Courses of Business Administration and Vice Versa.

In order to facilitate the proper process of allocation of Open Elective Courses, the colleges should make arrangements to provide proper orientation and guidelines to the students regarding the concept of Open Elective Courses as explained above and should display the list of Open Elective Courses.
