A., and founder & Chief Scientific Officer of Protherapeutics Singapore since 2005. His area of expertise includes Biochemistry, snake venom, enzyme and peptide sequence. His research works include 250 research publications, 18 books & chapters and 50 patent applications with 18,001 citations. Prof. Manjunath Kini has been listed as a noteworthy Biochemist by the American directory publisher. He serves as reviewer and editorial board for various international Journals .
